LS-1 Youth turns 14  
or comes into care after  
the age of 14

Advocate** are  
identified

Case Manager refers Youth (through  
FACES) to Older Youth Program  
**{Referral-Chafee Independence  
Services, Adolescent FST Guide and  
Individualized Action Plan Goals  
(CD-94)}**

After review, OYTS  
forwards referral to Chafee  
Provider or Region of  
Service OYTS

Chafee Provider

Case Manager

Invites  
Chafee  
Provider to  
FSTs,  
PPRTs,  
and TDM's

Completes **CD-94** via FACES  
at minimum of  
every 6 mths,  
and as goals  
are needed

Initial 30 days

Chafee Provider  
meets with Case  
Manager & Youth  
within 30 days of  
the referral
