History of Missouri Refugee Resettlement Program

- ▶ US Refugee Act of 1980 Adopted the UN refugee definition, created general policy for admission.
- MO Department of Social Services Administrator of Refugee Resettlement Programs until April 30, 2018
- MO-ORA ORR transferred administration of program May 1, 2018





What is MO-ORA?

- ► Replacement Designee (RD) for the State
- Administers certain Refugee programs for Missouri
- Separate, autonomous office within IISTL
- Provide resources, training, coordination, advocacy



Who are Eligible for these Services?

<u>Refugees</u> - The 1951 Refugee Convention defines a refugee as:

"someone who is unable or unwilling to return to their country of origin owing to a well-founded fear of being persecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group, or political opinion."

Currently 100,000,000 displaced worldwide




UNHCR – Durable Solutions

- 1st priority: Return to home country
- 2nd priority: Remain in country of asylum
- 3rd priority: Last resort Third country resettlement
 - ~1% of world's refugees are referred, to UNHCR
 - Top 5 countries that resettle refugees: U.S, Canada, Australia, UK, and Sweden
 - UNHCR attempts to match refugees to country requirements

- Asylees
- Paroled as refugee or political
- Certified Victims of Trafficking
- Cuban/Haitian Entrants
- Certain Amerasians from Vietnam
- ► Iraqi and Afghan Special Immigrants (SIVs)
- Afghan Humanitarian Parolees
- Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees
- Permanent Resident Aliens who previously held one of the refugee statuses
